Weather Data API (Global) - Detailed Common Specification

API key

To access the API, two API keys must be put in the request header.

If two API keys are not put, errors will occur and the requested data will not be returned.

request header	value
apikey	{APIkey}
x-api-key	{APIkey}

Example of command: curl https://*****/v2/XXXXXX.json -H "apikey:[APIKEY]" -H "x-api-key:[X-API-KEY]"

Content-Type of Response Header

application/json;charset=UTF-8

Limitation on Number of Calls

The API has a limit on the number of requests.

If the number of requests exceeds the limit, the requested data will not be returned, resulting in a 429 error code. [429 Too Many Requests].

Error

API errors will be indicated in the status of the response header status and message (message).

Response header	Response body	Description
status	message	
401	Invalid authentication credentials	When user authentication fails
403	You cannot consume this service	When user authentication has been performed but there is no permission to access the API, or when the API key is invalid
404	Not Found	When the URL is incorrect
429	Too many requests	When there is a limit on the number of requests and the limit is exceeded
502	An invalid response was received from the upstream server	When API server malfunction
